If you are in Foreclosure:

Foreclosure Mediation Hotline at

Foreclosure Mediation Program provides
homeowners who are in foreclosure with
access to housing counselors and court
trained mediators to resolve foreclosure
actions. A mediator and counselor will
work with you and your lender to work
out your mortgage so that your future
payments will be affordable to you.

If you are not in Foreclosure:

But you have missed a payment or payments or feel that you will soon miss a payment because your mortgage is no longer affordable to you, you should call your mortgage servicer. COMMUNITY JUSTICE CENTER

Disabled veterans and others can now benefit from free and low-cost services offered by a newly formed non-profit law firm, Community Justice Center.
